1. **Surf Boat Championships**  
Canterbury Surf Boat Championships – hosted by Rarangi SLSC  
**FEBRUARY 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> 2010**  
**Whites Bay, Blenheim.**

This year the Surf Boat Championships has been moved to Blenheim and placed on a separate weekend. This will enable Surf Boat crews to compete in the “sand” championships the following week.

2. **Event Order** - Due to the nature of the beach environment event orders may change.

The Carnival Controller will determine event orders.

The programme is presented as a guide only, as often competitors' events clash across arenas so it is important that some flexibility is retained to ensure the event is run efficiently as possible.

**Note there are particular times for each arena to start:**

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> Feb:

Long Course Surf Boat 1pm – (Predicted Conclusion 4pm)

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> Feb:

Short Course Surf Boat 9am – (Predicted Conclusion 11am)

Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> Feb:

IRB Arena 8am – (predicted conclusion 11am)

Male and Female Arena's 11am – (predicted Conclusion 2pm)

Central Arena – 2pm (predicted conclusion 4:30pm)

Beach Arena – 2pm (predicted conclusion 4:30pm)

Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> Feb:

Canoe Arena 8am – (predicted Conclusion 10am)

Swim and Small craft/central Arena 10am – (predicted conclusion 4pm)

Beach Flags Arena – 11am (predicted conclusion 2pm)

3. **Entries Close:** 5pm Wednesday 10 February
4. **Late entries** will be accepted at the Managers' Meeting on the day of the event only and only subject to available space in each event. Double entry fee applies.
5. **Competitor Numbers** – all competitors (excluding IRB, Masters & non-Canterbury competitors) Will be allocated a number. All competitors are required to write this number in permanent marker on both lower legs before competing. If a competitor does not have a number they need to get one from the results desk in the clubhouse.
6. **Radio Avon Trophy** – points towards winning this trophy can only be accumulated in the competitor's respective age-group.

7. **Prize Giving Ceremonies** – these will be commenced at the conclusion of EACH arenas events throughout the carnival.
8. **Parking** – spectators and competitors are asked ***not to park in the immediate vicinity of the clubhouse.*** This space is reserved for Officials and equipment parking.
9. **Security** – is being provided overnight on Saturday so equipment/gear may be left in the immediate vicinity of the clubhouse. However SLSC takes no responsibility for any gear that goes missing.
10. **Entry Fees** –  
  
Individual Entry - \$20 (enter as many individual events as you wish)  
Team Entry - \$10 per team per event.  
Surf Boat Team Entry - \$15 per team per event.
10. **Entry Form Process** -
  1. Open the Excel workbook file [Canterbury Champs Entry Form.xls](#)
  2. Enter the details of your club contact.
  3. Click on either the MEN tab or WOMEN tab at the bottom of the screen to choose to enter Men's or Women's entries.
  4. List your athletes in column A. Please write both their first name and last name in Full. Only write each individual once.
  5. Working along the columns select which events that individual will be racing.
  6. When you reach the Teams events (as you scroll across to the right of the page) enter the name of the team that the individual is a member of. For example if Jo Smith and Jane Smith are in the mixed double ski and they are team "a" (could be a colour, object, animal, number if you wish) then both Jo and Jane and only Jo and Jane should have an "a" in their column.
