

As a member of the Taylors Mistake Surf Life Saving Club (TMSLSC) you must adhere to the following Code of Conduct.

If at any stage the rules and Code of Conduct are not adhered to you will be removed from the training session or competition. If you are at a competition out of town, you will be put on the first available flight/bus back to Christchurch at your own (or parents) expense.

Further disciplinary actions may also be undertaken at a club level; a national level or both, or may be forwarded to other enforcement agencies such as the police.

Taylor's Mistake Surf Lifesaving expects all members, supporters, advisors, staff and associates of TMSLSC to abide by a Code of Conduct that upholds the principles and values of the organisation. Members should recognize that at all times they have a responsibility to a duty of care for all TMSLSC members.

All teams will travel in club uniform. You will be advised of the appropriate uniform prior to departure by the team manager.

RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

You must:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all other members of the team, including the coaches and managers.
2. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
3. Be a positive role model for others.
4. Refrain from any form of abuse, harassment, discrimination or victimisation towards others.
5. Never act in any way that may bring disrepute or disgrace to TMSLSC members, its stakeholders and/or its sponsors, potential sponsors and/or partners.
6. Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adherence to, standards, rules, regulations and policies of TMSLSC and SLSNZ.
7. Members must respect their equipment and the equipment of others. It is the member's responsibility to find replacement gear should theirs get damaged.
8. Members must not possess, consume, or purchase alcohol except with the consent of the Team Manager. In the case of minors, the team manager may be given permission by parents to act as guardian and supervise the consumption of a very limited amount of alcohol. Any minors who become intoxicated will not attend the after-function. They will remain behind under the care of the manager.

The following Items are banned:

- Drugs and tobacco
- All medications must be documented and a list provided to the Team Manager. The use of any medications not listed will be considered a breach of the rules.
